#### **TEXTBOOK ADOPTION**

BP 5030

The Director of Curriculum shall recommend to the Board of Education the adoption of all textbooks and supplementary instructional materials, per state Department of Education requirements. In the selection of textbooks, he/she will conduct the textbook adoption process in cooperation with the identified committee of teachers, principals, and representatives from student and community groups he/she may appoint, or who are appointed.

The Director of Curriculum shall be responsible for establishing criteria by which additional instructional materials (supplementary books, teaching supplies, technology, etc...) may be provided, and shall make provisions for the purchase of such materials within the annual student fee proposal submitted to the Board of Education. The textbook adoption process will consider the necessity for and economical impact of all materials proposed for adoption and usage.

Teachers shall use the instructional materials selected by the textbook adoption committee, and approved by the Board of Education. Recommendations for proposed changes must be filed with the Director of Curriculum, and are subject to the approval of the Board of Education, during the semester prior to the intended usage.



# Public Statement by Superintendent Judi Hendrix with regard to the reinstatement of Brian Hole at Western Boone (March 14, 2011)

In light of his recent acquittal on the criminal charge of voyeurism arising from the March 2010 locker room incident at the Jr.-Sr. High School, the School Board has reinstated Brian Hole to his teaching position effective immediately.

Last March, as required by law, the administration immediately reported these allegations to local law enforcement which conducted an investigation. Criminal charges were later filed against Mr. Hole, but at trial the judge found the evidence was insufficient to support a conviction.

Mr. Hole has been punished for the misconduct which caused him to be suspended from his teaching duties without pay. That misconduct was solely his admitted failure to be forthright and consistent in responding to school administrators' inquiries regarding the incident.

The court's finding concludes the criminal case. At this time the suspension will be lifted and Mr. Hole's pay will be reinstated effective his return to work.

We are confident he is aware of his personal and professional obligations and our expectation that he meet those obligations.

# **GENERAL FUND COMPARISON REPORT:**

As of the end of February, 2011 the General Fund cash balance is \$1,954,306.28.

In the General Fund as of February 28, 2011, we have expended a total of \$1,418,868 or 13% of the 2011 General Fund Appropriated Budget of \$11,555,700.
