Dear Board Members:

As you know, the schedule for school board elections has changed such that board members are now elected in the November general election rather than in the May primary. So, for this year, those terms that normally end June 30th will continue through the end of 2012.

Superintendent Hendrix me that it is the board's intent to have a reorganizational meeting in July to get us through the rest of 2012 and then have another one in early 2013 to make decisions applicable to next year.

It has been our practice to annually offer our continued services as general counsel for the coming fiscal year with action taken on that decision at your summer reorganizational meeting. Under the present circumstances, I we are willing to continue to serve as general counsel for the Western Boone School Board Members June 22, 2012 Page 2

balance of 2012 on the same terms and conditions as are outlined in my letter of last June that you approved early last July.

If this is agreeable with you, you may merely approve the continuation of the current arrangement through the balance of this calendar year. I prefer not to get ahead of ourselves and try to make arrangements for 2013, because we don't know who the school board members will be at that time. I think they should have the opportunity to make those decisions when they are sworn into office.
