EDUCATION & OPERATION FUND COMPARISON REPORT

As of July 31, 2020, the Education Fund cash balance was \$3,261,513. The Education Fund expenditures for July 2020 were \$774,955. As of the end of July 2020, a total of 52% of the 2020 appropriation was expended.

As of July 31, 2020, the Operation Fund cash balance was \$1,263,753. The Operation Fund expenditures for July 2020 were \$685,655. As of the end of July 2020, a total of 48% of the 2020 appropriation was expended.
