

A RESOLUTION TO BECOME THE ADMINISTERING CORPORATION OF THE COOPERATIVE PROGRAM KNOWN AS THE BOONE-CLINTON-NORTH WEST HENDRICKS COOPERATIVE

The Lebanon Community School Corporation, by its Board of School Trustees (hereinafter "Board"), on March 20, 2012, pursuant to I.C. 20-35-5 et seq. (hereinafter "I.C.") § , resolves to be responsible for receiving and disbursing funds, executing documents, maintaining records, and providing contracts for Cooperative Program personnel pursuant to the agreement attached as Tab "A."

Effective Date: This proposed resolution shall become effective as of the adoption of this resolution and execution of the agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the superintendent, school corporation legal counsel and the officers of this Board shall take all other actions and execute all other documents as are reasonably convenient or otherwise necessary to affect execution of the cooperative agreement with Lebanon Community School Corporation as the Administering Corporation.

TEXTBOOK ADOPTION

BP-5030

The Director of Curriculum shall recommend to the Board of Education the adoption of all textbooks and supplementary instructional materials, per State Department of Education requirements. In the selection of textbooks, he/she will conduct the textbook adoption process in cooperation with the identified committee of teachers. The chosen textbook selection will be decided by a majority vote of the committee.

The Director of Curriculum shall be responsible for establishing criteria by which additional instructional materials (supplementary books, teaching supplies, technology, etc.) may be provided, and shall make provisions for the purchase of such materials within the annual student fee proposal submitted to the Board of Education. The textbook adoption process will consider the necessity for and economical impact of all materials proposed for adoption and usage.

The Director of Curriculum will observe the State Board of Education textbook rental cap of 25% of the purchased price per year for a period of six years, and 15% per year if continued after six years.

Teachers shall use the instructional materials selected by the textbook adoption committee, and approved by the Board of Education. Recommendations for proposed changes must be filed with the Director of Curriculum, and are subject to the approval of the Board of Education, during the semester prior to the intended usage.

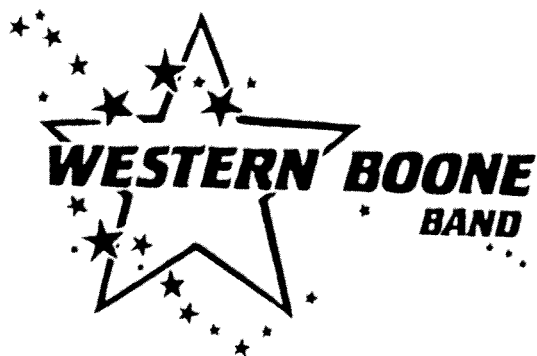

Western Boone Athletic Student Handbook Changes – 2012-2013

ACADEMIC POINTS: An athlete in grades 9-12 may receive additional points toward a jacket through academic achievement. Points will only be earned for the scholastic cumulative GPA at the end of each academic school year. (Points earned will be added at the end of the academic year only.) If a student athlete is not in a spring sport, but if they think their end of year academic points may put them at 26 points or higher, qualifying them for a letter jacket, the student athlete may write a letter to the Athletic Director no later than May 1 requesting a review of academic points and total points for a letter jacket.

1. A cumulative GPA of 3.67 or higher as it relates to Western Boone's 4.0 scale....3 points
2. A cumulative GPA of 3.33 to 3.66 as it relates to Western Boone's 4.0 scale...2points
3. A cumulative GPA of 2.67 to 3.32 as it relates to Western Boone's 4.0 scale1 point

We have added the ability for a student athlete to get 2 points. In the past, it was only 1 or 3 points. And, we also have put in language that allows a student athlete who does not play a spring sport to have us check their academic points after the school year if the points will put them over the top for their letter jacket.

GENERAL FUND COMPARISON REPORT:

As of the end of March, 2012 the General Fund cash balance is \$1,609,737. In the General Fund as of March, 31, 2012 or the first quarter of 2012, we have expended a total of \$2,654,750 or 23% of the 2012 General Fund Appropriated Budget of \$11,782,150. March was a 3-pay month which is why more was expended this month.

The Corporation has not received any reimbursement for the 2011-2012 Special Ed Federal Grant as this date. Under normal circumstances, we would have receipted a total \$150,189 into our General Fund as of March, 2012. Once the process has been completed and the LEA has been officially changed to Lebanon School Corporation, reimbursement requests will be resubmitted and we should start receiving money from the 2011-2012 Special Ed Federal Grant.
