Re: Life & LTD Insurance

In 2000, the Western Boone County Community School Corporation was allowed to break away from the WV/WCI School Trust for their Life/AD&D and LTD Insurance coverage in an attempt to get a better rate. Our Corporation was able to find a lower rate with Sun Life Insurance and thus we changed our Life/AD&D/LTD coverage plan in January, 2001. Our rates with Sun Life have had minimal to no change in the past 12 years. The Life/AD&D Insurance rate has never changed and the LTD has increased only slightly. One of the key reasons that the corporation chose to stay with Sun Life Insurance was that they allowed the retired teachers to maintain their life insurance coverage at their expense which many life insurance policies do not have this option.

In October, 2012 the WV/WCI School Trust voted to change their policy in which a school corporation had to maintain their Life/AD&D, LTD and Health Insurance coverage all within the school trust by June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2013.

The current WV/WCI School Trust rates for Life and AD&D Insurance will be .14 per \$1,000 of coverage and LTD will be .394% per an employee's annual salary. Our current rates with Sun Life are .17 for Life and AD&D Insurance and .513% for LTD. This change could amount to a possible savings of \$12,300 annually for the corporation.

The main issue that arose was that the School Trust did not have a provision which would cover or allow the rollover of the Western Boone Retired Teachers into the School Trust Life Insurance Plan. Our current Western Boone Teacher Contract states that a retired teacher will have the option to continue on the school's life insurance plan upon retirement, but at their expense.

After many discussions, the WV/WCI School Trust is adding a separate provision which will allow the Western Boone Retired Teachers the option to maintain a life insurance policy. This will be a separate life insurance policy from the School Corporation's and their rates will not be the same; however, they will be allowed to continue their life insurance coverage if they so choose.

Due to the fact that the WV/WCI School Trust has mandated this coverage change, has better rates for Life/AD&D and LTD Insurance and is meeting the provision for our retired teachers, I would like to request that the board approve that Western Boone County Community School Corporation cancel their current Life and LTD Insurance policy with Sun Life Insurance effective May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2013 and change the corporation's coverage to WV/WCI School Trust Life and LTD Insurance which would be effective June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2013.

I would also like to request that the Board move forward on changing the three Principal's Life Insurance coverage from \$50,000 to \$100,000 effective June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2013.

**NON-RESIDENT STUDENT ADMISSION****BP 6195**

The Board of School Trustees recognizes that a child must be a legal resident of the Western Boone County Community School Corporation in order to attend its schools. The Board further recognizes that extenuating circumstances often arise and it is for these cases that the following regulations have been adopted.

It is the intent of the Board that all applicable policies and laws in regard to student transfers shall be strictly enforced.

Requests by parents, guardians, or custodians of Indiana students who do not reside in the Western Boone County Community School Corporation but who wish to enroll their child in the school system will be considered for enrollment if:

- Non-resident enrollment is for educational reasons;
- Non-resident student is in good standing in their resident school corporation;
- Parents, guardians, or custodians agree to provide transportation to and from the school, unless there is an established residence in our district with an adult accepting responsibility of this arrangement.
- Once the written request (see application form) is submitted it will not need to be renewed unless the parents/guardians and student are notified differently by the administration.
- Not for athletic purposes.
- Payment of all Textbooks and Fees must be made before or on the first day of attendance.
- Those who move out of district, after they have been counted on ADM, may request to stay. They must complete the Transfer Form, be in good standing and acquire principal signature of approval.

The decision on Acceptance of a non-resident student will be based upon:

- The student's attendance (no more than 8 excused absences the previous semester) and academic record (passing all subjects the previous semester and at least a B grade point average) at the previous school.
- The student's disciplinary record at the previous school. A student may be accepted who has not had a major disciplinary infraction (i.e., fighting, alcohol, illegal controlled substances, truancy, etc.) as determined by the receiving school.
- Class size of the grade level in which the student is enrolling.
- A student may be accepted if his/her needs can be accommodated with current staffing and program offerings and whose enrollment does not adversely affect the programming for resident students.
- The transfer shall not place any undue financial burden on the Western Boone County Community School Corporation.
- There is no outstanding debt owed to the sending corporation.

Students transferring to the Corporation from other schools shall be placed in those classes or at those grade levels for which their previous educational experiences appear to qualify them. The School Corporation reserves the right to change or modify such placements on the basis of later information, testing, or investigation. The School Corporation may dismiss any student who does not comply with the above criteria while attending Western Boone Schools.

Students and parents may be asked to participate in an interview by the principal or designee of the receiving school prior to the consideration of the transfer.

**SUBJECT:** Bus Driver Pay

Attached you will find a sheet detailing our thoughts on a new pay scale for our bus drivers. We have had a pay scale for years that paid all corporation routes the same. Our current scale does not take into account the length of time spent on the routes. Contractors were paid based on their miles. I was asked to look into this and make a recommendation for a new pay scale that is more equitable to all since all routes are now owned by the corporation.

I asked for information from five local school corporations that are very similar to Western Boone and received information from four of these schools. Two of the schools have a system like we have in place currently, the other two schools have a pay scale that takes into account time spent on each route. Both of these schools use a base rate for all routes then customize the driver pay using time spent on each route along with an experience factor for each driver. Our scale steps up the daily pay for five years to compensate experience.

The new plan attached uses a three tier pay scale based on the time spent on the route, mileage and number of riders. Column two gives a driver an additional \$3 per day or \$543 per year, column three gives a driver an additional \$6 per day or \$1,086 per year. This represents an increase of \$13,641.97 or 3.20% for a more equitable plan of compensation.

I am also recommending the addition of a \$500 perfect attendance stipend to reward our drivers for not missing time from their routes. We have discussed this benefit as a meaningful incentive to reward our drivers.
