Re: Spring 2017 IREAD-3 Results

IREAD-3 was administered March 13-17, 2017 to all Indiana third graders. On May 12, 2017, the Indiana Department of Education lifted the embargo of the aggregated assessment results, enabling the results to be shared publicly. The Indiana Department of Education has established 90% as the passing rate that schools must strive to meet.

Western Boone had a combined passing rate of 93%. Individually, Granville Wells had a passing rate of 97% passing, and Thorntown had a passing rate of 89%. All students who do not pass the Spring IREAD-3 test have an opportunity to take the test again in the summer, after participating in remediation programs that take place during the school year or summer. Six students participated in the retest last week, and the administrators are confident that the passing rate will increase when the results of the Summer IREAD-3 Retest results are returned later in June.

The recommended elementary textbook fees for the 2017-2018 school year are listed below. Fee increases will be necessary at grades four through six, due to the adoption of a new science curriculum. In addition, in lieu of purchasing costly materials kits from the publishers, a consumable fee was added to grades five and six to purchase items for science activities in the classroom. WELLNESS POLICY

BP - 6360

The board believes that good nutrition, healthy eating patterns, and physical activity are important for academic achievement and lifelong health. Western Boone County Community School Corporation supports participation in the National School Lunch and Breakfast Program and, in accordance with federal law, establishes this Wellness Policy. To promote student wellness, the district supports goals in the following seven areas:

I. Advisory Council

1. In accordance with Indiana Code 20-26-9-18, and the Healthy, Hunger Free Kids Act of 2010 (HHFKA), the school corporation will maintain a School Healthy Advisory Council to include the following individuals: parent, Food Service Director, staff member, student, health care professional/registered dietitian, physical education teacher, school board member, administrator, interested members of the general public, and representatives of interested community organizations.
2. The Advisory Council shall meet to review the Wellness Policy at least once annually.
3. The Advisory Council shall report annually to the board if changes are made to Wellness Policy, BP 6360

II. Nutrition Education and Promotion

1. Students in grades K-12 will receive nutrition education to support adoption of healthy eating behaviors.
2. Nutrition education will be included with health education curriculum standards and guidelines.
3. Schools will support activities that promote nutrition awareness in conjunction with the school health program.
4. Posters will be displayed prominently in the cafeteria to encourage healthy eating.
5. Foods of minimal nutritional value, including brands and illustrations, shall not be advertised or marketed in educational materials.

III. School Meal Content Standards

1. Meals served through the National School Lunch and Breakfast Program will:
 - Be appealing and appetizing to children;
 - Meet, at a minimum, the nutrition requirements established by the USDA for federal funding programs;
 - Contain 0 percent trans fats;
 - Offer a variety of fruits and vegetables;
 - Provide 100 % of the grains offered are whole grain rich, unless a waiver has been obtained.
2. All cooked foods will be baked or steamed. Proper procurement procedures and preparation methods will be used to decrease excess fat, calorie and sodium levels in food.
3. Schools are encouraged to purchase or obtain fresh fruits and vegetables from local farmers when practical.
4. Students will have the opportunity to provide input on local, cultural and ethnic food choices.
5. The food service department shall provide periodic food promotions that will allow for taste testing of new healthier foods being introduced on the menu.
6. Special dietary needs of students will be considered when planning meals in accordance with guidance outlined in, "Accommodating Children with Special Dietary Needs in the School Nutrition Programs".

IV. Nutrition Standards for Competitive and Other Food and Beverages on School Campuses

1. The Board will provide and allow foods and beverages that support proper nutrition, promote healthy choices and comply with federal nutrition standards in vending machines, (smart snack). This also includes food and beverages made available in schools during the school day for such events as birthdays and classroom celebrations.
2. The Board will allow marketing in school buildings and on school grounds during the school day for only those food and beverages provided by the school that meet the federal nutritional standards. Marketing that promotes student health will be permitted in school buildings and on school grounds.

3. All food available for sale to students including vending machines, student stores, and fund raisers should offer food choices that provide the opportunity for students to select products that reflect healthy and nutritional principles and lifestyles and follow the USDA guidelines and the Department of Education.
4. All food sales must comply with state and federal nutrition program regulations/guidelines (Smart Snack compliance and HHFKA 2010).
5. At least 50% of the items offered in beverage and food vending machines that are available to students shall meet the definition of healthy beverages and healthy foods as defined below:
 - Healthy beverages: water, milk, fruit drinks with at least 50 % fruit juice, vegetable drinks, and 100 % fruit juices.
 - Healthy foods: any food item that does not have more than 30% total calories from fat, and more than 10% of the recommended daily value for one of the following nutrients: vitamin A, vitamin C, calcium, iron, protein, or fiber.
6. All beverages and food items sold to students will be offered at comparable prices for comparable size packages.

V. Physical Activity

1. Students will be given opportunities for physical activity during the day through physical education classes, daily recess periods for elementary students or the integration of physical activity into the academic curriculum.
2. Students will be given opportunities for physical activity through a range of before and after-school programs including, but not limited to, intramurals, interscholastic athletics, and activity clubs.
3. Schools will encourage parents and guardians to support their children's participation in physical activity, to be physically active role models, and to include physical activity in family activities.
4. Schools will promote good nutrition and lifelong physical activity.

VI. Other School Based Activities

1. The schools will host activities such as, Jump for Heart, Girls on the Run and The Presidential Fitness Test, for those students who participate.
2. Fitness Grams administered by Witham Health Services once a year at the elementary level.

VII. Western Boone County Community School Corporation will Promote Student Wellness by:

1. Providing a clean, safe, enjoyable meal environment for students.
2. Encouraging all students to participate in the school meal program and protecting the identity of students who eat free and reduced price meals.
3. Scheduling lunch times as near the middle of the day as possible.
4. Ensuring that school fundraising efforts support healthy and positive dietary products and lifestyles.
5. Making the wellness policy available to students and families on the corporation website.

VIII. Evaluation

1. Western Boone County Community Schools is committed to enforcing the policies and guidelines included in this document. Through implementation of the School Wellness Policy, the corporation will create an environment that supports opportunities for physical activity and healthy eating behaviors.
2. The Wellness Policy will be evaluated, every three years, through the Indiana Department of Education Wellness Policy Evaluation Tool and notified the public of the results.
3. The Food Service Director is responsible for continuously monitoring this policy.

Re: Rainy Day Fund

Per the Indiana Code, a Rainy Day Fund is a financial line that can be established so that it may assist the school corporation in emergency situations or provide available funds to cover a project which is not part of the Capital Project Plan.

The Western Boone School Board originally established a Rainy Day Fund in 2002. The following have been the authorized transfers into the Rainy Day Fund:

2002	-	\$ 92,300
2008	-	\$100,000
2010	-	\$295,000
2011	-	\$100,000
2012	-	\$375,562.44
2014	-	\$150,000
2015	-	\$150,000
2016	-	\$150,000

The current cash balance of the Rainy Day Fund is \$1,188,803. Per the Board approval, a Teacher Retirement Incentive was offered which will be paid out on August 4th, 2017 in the amount of \$60,000. .

As of December 31, 2016, the corporation had unexpended appropriated dollars remaining in the Transportation and Bus Replacement Funds which is not figured into the 2017 appropriated budget. I would like to make the recommendation to the Board that we transfer the following into the Rainy Day Fund:

Transportation Fund:	\$100,000
Bus Replacement Fund:	<u>\$100,000</u>
TOTAL:	\$200,000

This would bring the total Rainy Day Fund to \$1,328,803.

BOARD RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER FUNDS

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 36-1-8-5.1 allows a school corporation to establish a Rainy Day Fund to transfer unused and unencumbered balances from funds raised by a tax levy, up to a maximum of ten percent of the total budget for that fiscal year,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board hereby transfers \$100,000 from the Transportation Fund (Fund 410); and \$100,000 from the Bus Replacement Fund (Fund 420) to the Rainy Day Fund (Fund 610) for the 2016-2017 fiscal year.

The intent of the Board of School Trustees is to use the monies in the Rainy Day Fund for purposes the Board deems necessary.

This resolution was duly made, seconded and adopted this 12th day of June, 2017.

North Central Coop has offered to contract 42,000 gallons of diesel fuel for the August through May time frame at a cost of \$1.94 per gallon plus \$.16 fuel tax.

The 42,000 gallons, is our typical usage through the school year.

This is \$.025 less than the contracted price paid over the past school year.

The past 3 years, I have been satisfied with the service North Central Coop has provided keeping the fuel available, the pumps serviced, and the quality of the fuel during cold temperatures.

I recommend the approval of the fuel contract with North Central Coop for the August through May months for 42,000 gallons of diesel fuel.
