ILEARN Checkpoints: The Indiana Department of Education is moving to a through-year assessment schedule in the 25-26 school year for students in grades 3-6. This means that students will take shorter segments of the ILEARN test at various points during the year, as well as a summative assessment in April. This year, Western Boone Schools is piloting this program to help our instructional staff better understand this evaluation process and necessary instructional planning for subsequent years. Checkpoint 1 results for students in grades 3-6 can be viewed in your child's Harmony account.
