Grades 4-6 Human Sexuality Presentations: The Indiana General Assembly passed legislation, effective July 1, 2018, that requires each school corporation to make available for inspection to a parent all the instructional materials used in connection with instruction on human sexuality. Prior to a school providing a student with instruction on human sexuality, the school must provide the parent of the student with a written request for consent of instruction. The written consent form may be sent in an electronic format. The link to the consent form is attached. The consent form contains links to the curricular materials. Please fill the form out and either consent to the instruction or deny consent. **A student will receive the human sexuality instruction if the consent has not been completed.** If you have any questions about the curriculum specifically, we encourage you to attend a virtual parent informational meeting on January 13th, from 5:00-6:00 p.m.
