New Students: Enrollment for new students for the 25-26 school year is now open. Preschool children should be 4 years of age by August 1st, and kindergartners should be 5 years of age by August 1st. The fee for our preschool is \$270 a month. We are accepting deposits and parent agreements for the preschool program now. Additionally, we are accepting students living outside our district for all grade levels pending there is space availability and certain criteria are met.
